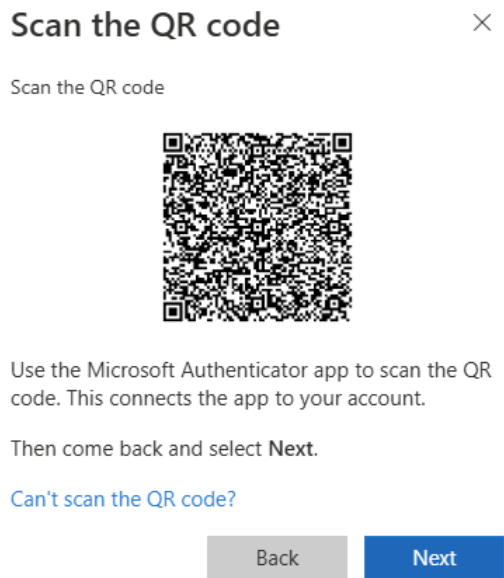
6. Download and Install Microsoft Authenticator on your mobile device. And Next.
